## who we Serve

The MANSEF schools serve more than 4000 students each year. Under the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), all children with special needs must receive a free appropriate public education (FAPE) in the least restrictive environment. Students referred to MANSEF schools, through the IEP process, require specialized services not always available in their local public school.


